- 1. General Rules**

The committee is moderated by the moderator assigned by the Secretariat. General rules including scope, quorum, dress code and powers of the secretariat are governed by MUNIST 2017 rules of procedure and code of conduct. For language and courtesy, please see section "Notes". The rules governing courtesy are not covered under MUNIST 2017 rules of procedure.

2. Powers of Moderator

In JCC: US Prohibition Act of 1927, Chicago Outfit Cabinet will be moderated by Al Capone, and Federal Bureau of Investigation will be chaired by Elliot Ness. Moderators of both cabinets have the jurisdiction to approve or reject directives submitted by members, other than personal directives, and will moderate the debate. The vote of moderators are equal with other members of the cabinets. Motions or points may be overruled by the moderator and are not subject to appeal.

3. Powers of Secretariat of JCC: US Prohibition Act of 1927

Secretariat of JCC: US Prohibition Act of 1927 has the jurisdiction to implement the directives after they are approved by the moderator, respond to personal directives.

4. Rules Governing Substantial Matters

The cabinets' substantial documents are directives. Directives must be signed by the members who request the directive to be implemented. Directives must be detailed, and within the jurisdiction of submitter.

Collective Directive: Collective directive is a directive signed by all members of the cabinet. Collective directive also needs to be approved by the moderator and secretariat.

Personal Directive: Personal directive is a confidential directive to gather information from the Secretariat or to implement an action within the jurisdiction of the member that submitted the directive. Personal directives do not require approval from the moderator.

Military Directive: The directives can be raids, deployment of forces, creating checkpoints and et cetera. Elliot Nessa can participate in the drafting process of military directives, and sign them.

Press Release: Press releases are obliged to include the signature(s) of the member(s) of the cabinet.

Governmental Directive: Governmental directives can entail all measures within the jurisdiction of the members of the Government in the Federal Bureau of Investigation.

5. Rules Governing Debate

Points

Point of Order: Point of order can be proposed in case of an improper use of parliamentary procedure.

Point of Personal Privilege: Point of personal privilege can be proposed in case of an inconvenience that prevents delegates to listen to another delegate emerges.

Motions

Motion for Semi Moderated Caucus: Semi-moderated caucus is proposed when members of the Cabinets want to debate on a specific topic. Semi moderated cauci shall be proposed without total time and individual time limitations. Moderator can terminate a debate on discretion, or put an end to a speech if he/she feels necessary to do so, and these discretions are not subject to appeal.

Motion for Suspension: Motion for the suspension of the meeting shall be proposed by the end of the session as scheduled by MUNIST 2017.

Motion for Adjournment: Motion for the adjournment of the meeting shall be proposed by the end of the conference as scheduled by MUNIST 2017.

6. Notes

For the sake of the simulation, the members of the cabinets can use slangs. Necessary use of aggressiveness is tolerable, however, badgering another member of the cabinet is subjected to academic warning.

The common Italian slangs are allowed during the sessions, the official language of the cabinets are still English.

Delegates shall be aware of the fact that their characters can be assassinated by the members of the Cabinets. In case, they will be allocated to another character assigned by the Secretariat of JCC: US Prohibition Act of 1927.
